Dear Speaker Pelosi and Minority Leader McCarthy:

On behalf of the 80 companies, unions and NGOs in the Carbon Capture Coalition (see attached), we write to thank you for providing floor time for H.R. 4447, the Clean Economy Jobs and Innovation Act, which would spur investment in clean energy technologies and help put the U.S. on track to decarbonize our economy by 2050.

Many of the Carbon Capture Coalition's priorities for economywide development and deployment of carbon capture, utilization, removal and storage are part of Title III of the bill, Carbon Pollution Reduction Technologies, including the following:

- Authorization of a commercial carbon capture, utilization and storage commercialization program (\$7.5 billion over five years);
- Reauthorization of saline geologic storage research, development and demonstration (RD&D) programs (\$3.1 billion over five years);
- Authorization of a carbon utilization RD&D program (\$165 million over five years);
- Establishment of a carbon removal RD&D program, including a \$180 per ton direct air capture prize program through 2030; and
- Provisions to establish an industrial emissions technology program and technical assistance to implement industrial emissions reductions.

Energy innovation is a critical component of meeting midcentury climate goals. Your commitment to the expansion of these programs and policies will help our nation achieve a more secure, competitive and prosperous low-carbon future.

Thank you again for your leadership on these important issues. We stand ready to assist to help make the Clean Economy Jobs and Innovation Act become law.
