Dear Coalition participants, observers, and supporters,

Happy New Year! We hope you enjoyed a pleasant holiday season.

My apologies to those of you who have received this request multiple times. We are reaching out to request that you **review and sign the attached letter** addressed to congressional leadership **urging Congress to maintain critical bipartisan support for the 45Q tax credit and oppose any efforts to weaken its utility to American businesses.**

As you know, the incoming Republican leadership is organizing and planning for the 119th Congress, which is set to gavel in on Friday. As such, tax policy and an extension of the 2017 Tax Cuts and Jobs Act (TCJA) are at the forefront of those discussions. Ahead of negotiations around a budget resolution to kick off the process for consideration of budget reconciliation measures, the Republican majorities are currently working to identify off-sets for what we anticipate being a multi-trillion dollar tax title. **With this in mind, the full breadth of carbon management stakeholders must unite in an effort to protect the critical enhancements made to the foundational 45Q tax credit under the Inflation Reduction Act of 2022.**

That said, the Carbon Capture Coalition is leading a broad stakeholder letter to congressional leadership calling on Congress to maintain critical bipartisan support for the 45Q tax credit and oppose any efforts to weaken its utility. The letter places focus on four main areas:

- **CARBON MANAGEMENT AND THE 45Q TAX CREDIT AS A KEY ECONOMIC DRIVER;**
- **THE 45Q TAX CREDIT'S ROLE IN MAINTAINING GLOBAL ENERGY LEADERSHIP;**
- **ENSURING AMERICAN INDUSTRIES REMAIN GLOBALLY COMPETITIVE; and**
- **45Q'S ROLE IN GROWING US ELECTRICITY DEMAND.**

We believe we are at a pivotal moment and that this letter, with a broad, robust list of signatories could help ensure that policy support for 45Q and carbon management remain strong and protected throughout upcoming negotiations. **Please fill out the [linked Google Form](#) or contact Coalition staff by COB WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 8, to add your organization to the list of signatories.** We will need as much support from members in the Coalition as possible, as well as partners and many others outside the Coalition, so please **share [this google form link](#) with like-minded partners far and wide to help with signature recruitment.**

deadline.
