

Dear Implementation Working Group Participants,

Recently, the Department of Energy's (DOE) Office of Fossil Energy and Carbon Management (FECM) released a [Request for Information \(RFI\)](#) for industrial demonstration and deployment of carbon capture technologies. Responses will inform DOE of potential new focus areas and identify knowledge gaps regarding the deployment of carbon management technologies in the industrial sector. Questions address technological, economic and social barriers and opportunities. The intention of the RFI is for stakeholders and other partners to advise and provide information on the potential of industrial carbon capture demonstration and deployment projects in a variety of industrial sectors, including aluminum, ammonia, cement, glass, iron and steel, lime, petrochemicals, paper, refining, soda ash, and liquified natural gas sectors.

The RFI is primarily technical in nature, and we strongly encourage Carbon Capture Coalition members to draft individual, sector-specific responses, as the swift and appropriate allocation of DOE funds is integral for bringing carbon capture technologies to scale in the industrial sector.
