Purpose: Carbon Capture Impact (Impact), a 501(c)4 organization, is the premier national advocacy organization to advance durable, commonsense federal policy solutions for the nationwide deployment of carbon management technologies. A sister initiative of the Carbon Capture Coalition, Impact amplifies the voices of a broad, far-reaching network of advocates representing nearly every facet of the carbon management industry and stakeholder community.

Impact engages with lawmakers in all elements of their job, providing flexibility to drive forward the legislative priorities of Impact members.
